## CAPTAIN CHEATER'S STORY

Feeling betrayed and cheated by those he had trusted since he was eight years old, he joined **THE UNTEACHABLES** and now provides students with gadgets that allow them to cheat without getting caught. **CAPTAIN CHEATER**, as he is now known, tempts student with his "Cheat Stick," a device that has several cheating mechanisms. When students take a test they simply use the top of the pen as a scanner and scan the question from the test into the pen. Because the Cheat Stick is equipped with the world's second largest database (the largest one, of course, is owned and operated by Smarty Marty), it finds the right answer within seconds and then automatically writes the answer on the test in the student's handwriting using its internal manuscript sensor. The first time a student writes with the pen it conveniently records and memorizes the handwriting for the lifetime of the Cheat Stick.

**CAPTAIN CHEATER** also provides students with his "Undercover Cover Sheet" and fancy pencil called the "Invisi-Beam." These two gadgets are meant to work together: the student is able to write with invisible lead onto the undercover cover sheet, then uses the Invisi-Beam to reveal the writing. This way, a student can take the undercover cover sheet into class and use it as a cover sheet. The Invisi-Beam comes with a button on the side that shoots a laser over the paper to reveal the words on the page. Obviously, this is not only handy for taking tests but also passing notes. **CAPTAIN CHEATER** realizes that sooner or later you are probably going to get caught and he takes no responsibility for your actions. In fact, his "Cheat Launchers" are rockets that enable him to get away before being caught with you.

## CAPTAIN CHEATER'S TACTICS AND TOOLS

**CHEAT STICK** is a pen with the world's second largest database, built-in scanner and internal manuscript sensor. It is used to access and search for correct test answers and then writes the answer on the test in the student's handwriting. **UNDERCOVER COVER SHEET** contains the correct answers, which can only be revealed with the use of the Invisi-Beam.

**INVISI-BEAM** is a pencil that writes on the "undercover cover sheet" with invisible lead. It contains a laser that reveals what is written on the page.

**CHEAT LAUNCHERS** are rockets that allow him to get away before being caught with you.
